

Welcome to Holden

When you are purchasing a piece of property in Holden, it is the responsibility of the seller to notify the Holden Municipal Light Department of the closing date. A 48 hour notice is required.

As a Municipal Department, a release of lien is required to be generated. After the final bill is paid, a certificate is issued proving there are no monies owed on the property. The seller will supply us with the name of the new owner and services will be transferred on the day of the reading with no interruption of service.

If you are renting a piece of property, you must contact the Holden Municipal Light Department at (508)210-5400. All renters are required to pay a deposit on their new account. A new account cannot be established until the deposit is paid.

In order to establish an account for a rental property we require the following:

- A completed application for service
- A deposit – this will be applied to the final utility bill upon vacating the property
- Copy of driver's license
- If tenant is responsible for water, a copy of the page of the lease stating so
